"But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ." (1 Corinthians 15:57)

The Victor

Revelation 1:12-18 – (12) "Then I turned to see the voice that was speaking to me, and on turning I saw seven golden lampstands, (13) and in the midst of the lampstands one like a son of man, clothed with a long robe and with a golden sash around his chest. (14) The hairs of his head were white, like white wool, like snow. His eyes were like a flame of fire, (15) his feet were like burnished bronze, refined in a furnace, and his voice was like the roar of many waters. (16) In his right hand he held seven stars, from his mouth came a sharp two-edged sword, and his face was like the sun shining in full strength. (17) When I saw him, I fell at his feet as though dead. But he laid his right hand on me, saying, 'Fear not, I am the first and the last, (18) and the living one. I died, and behold I am alive forevermore, and I have the keys of Death and Hades.'"

<u>Revelation 5:5</u> – "And one of the elders said to me, 'Weep no more; behold, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, <u>has conquered</u>, so that he can open the scroll and its seven seals."

Romans 8:37 – "No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us."

"No, despite all these things, overwhelming victory is ours through Christ, who loved us." (Romans 8:37 NLT)

The Death Duo

Revelation 20:14 – "Then Death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. This is the second death, the lake of fire."

The Devil

Revelation 20:10 — "and the devil who had deceived them was thrown into the lake of fire and sulfur where the beast and the false prophet were, and they will be tormented day and night forever and ever."

The Debt

Colossians 2:13-15 – (13) "And you, who were dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, God made alive together with him, having forgiven us all our trespasses, (14) by canceling the record of debt that stood against us with its legal demands. This he set aside, nailing it to the cross. (15) He disarmed the rulers and authorities and put them to open shame, by triumphing over them in him."

The Decaying Realm

Revelation 21:1-5 – (1) "Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and the sea was no more. (2) And I saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. (3) And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, 'Behold, the dwelling place of God is with man. He will dwell with them, and they will be his people, and God himself will be with them as their God. (4) He will wipe away every tear from their eyes, and death shall be no more, neither shall there be mourning, nor crying, nor pain anymore, for the former things have passed away.' (5) And he who was seated on the throne said, 'Behold, I am making all things new.' Also he said, 'Write this down, for these words are trustworthy and true.'"
