"The New Life"

"We were buried therefore with him by baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life." (Romans 6:4)

Living another's Life

<u>John 5:19</u> – "So Jesus said to them, 'Truly, truly, I say to you, the Son can do nothing of his own accord, but only what he sees the Father doing. For whatever the Father does, that the Son does likewise."

<u>John 14:10</u> – "Do you not believe that I am in the Father and the Father is in me? The words that I say to you I do not speak on my own authority, but the Father who dwells in me does his works."

<u>Galatians 2:20</u> – "I have been crucified with Christ. <u>It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me</u>. <u>And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God</u>, who loved me and gave himself for me."

Give the Holy Spirit the Captain's Seat of Your Life

The New Life:

(1) Provides Power over Sin

"We know that Christ, being raised from the dead, will never die again; death no longer has dominion over him. For the death he died he died to sin, once for all, but the life he lives he lives to God. So you also must consider yourselves dead to sin and alive to God in Christ Jesus." (Romans 6:9-11)

"He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness. By his wounds you have been healed." (1 Peter 2:24)

(2) Forces out Fear

"For you did not receive the spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you have received the Spirit of adoption as sons, by whom we cry, 'Abba! Father!'" (Romans 8:15)

(3) Offers True Hope

"Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! According to his great mercy, he has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, to an inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading, kept in heaven for you," (1 Peter 1:3-4)

"I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship. Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect." (Romans 12:1-2)

<u>Prayer</u>: Father, help me through the Holy Spirit to allow the life of Jesus to be lived through me. Help me to yield myself as a living sacrifice that my mind may be renewed and that I not revert to the ways of this fallen world. Help me to not attempt to live in my own strength, goodness, and will power, but to live by faith as you work in me to will and to do of Your good pleasure. In Jesus name and for His glory, Amen.
