Avoiding Hysteria

<u>Isaiah 8:11-13</u> – (11) "For the LORD spoke thus to me with his strong hand upon me, and warned me not to walk in the way of this people, saying: (12) '<u>Do not call conspiracy</u> all that this people calls conspiracy, and do not fear what they fear, nor <u>be in dread</u>. (13) But the LORD of hosts, <u>him you shall honor as holy</u>. <u>Let him be your fear, and let him be your dread</u>."

Fear Reveals the Direction of One's Faith

People of Godly Faith/Fear:

Noah

"By faith Noah, being warned of God of things not seen as yet, <u>moved</u> with fear, prepared an ark to the saving of his house; by the which he condemned the world, and became heir of the righteousness which is by faith."

(Hebrews 11:7 KJV)

Shiphrah & Puah

"Then the king of Egypt said to the Hebrew midwives, one of whom was named Shiphrah and the other Puah, 'When you serve as midwife to the Hebrew women and see them on the birthstool, if it is a son, you shall kill him, but if it is a daughter, she shall live.' But the midwives feared God and did not do as the king of Egypt commanded them, but let the male children live. So the king of Egypt called the midwives and said to them, 'Why have you done this, and let the male children live?' The midwives said to Pharaoh, 'Because the Hebrew women are not like the Egyptian women, for they are vigorous and give birth before the

midwife comes to them.' So God dealt well with the midwives. And the people multiplied and grew very strong. And because the midwives feared God, he gave them families. (Exodus 1:15-21 ESV)

Jesus

"Who in the days of his flesh, when he had offered up prayers and supplications with strong crying and tears unto him that was able to save him from death, <u>and was heard in that he feared</u> (eulabeia – caution)"

(Hebrews 5:7 KJV)

"I charge you in the presence of God, who gives life to all things, and of Christ Jesus, who in his testimony before Pontius Pilate made the good confession" (1 Timothy 6:13)

"So Pilate said to him, 'You will not speak to me? Do you not know that I have authority to release you and authority to crucify you?' Jesus answered him, 'You would have no authority over me at all unless it had been given you from above...'" (John 19:10-11)
