Pressures Aplenty

<u>2 Corinthians 4:8</u> – "<u>We are hard pressed on every side</u>, but not crushed; perplexed, but not in despair;" (NIV)

<u>2 Corinthians 11:26-28</u> – ²⁶ "...in danger from rivers, danger from robbers, danger from my own people, danger from Gentiles, danger in the city, danger in the wilderness, danger at sea, danger from false brothers; ²⁷ in toil and hardship, through many a sleepless night, in hunger and thirst, often without food, in cold and exposure. ²⁸ And, apart from other things, there is <u>the daily pressure</u> on me of my anxiety for all the churches.."

<u>2 Corinthians 12:7-10</u> – ⁷ "So to keep me from becoming conceited because of the surpassing greatness of the revelations, a thorn was given me in the flesh, a messenger of Satan to harass me, to keep me from becoming conceited. ⁸ Three times I pleaded with the Lord about this, that it should leave me. ⁹ But he said to me, 'My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.' Therefore I will boast all the more gladly of my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ may rest upon me. ¹⁰ For the sake of Christ, then, I am content with weaknesses, insults, hardships, persecutions, and calamities. For when I am weak, then I am strong."

Prevailing through God

<u>Romans 8:36-37</u> $-^{36}$ "As it is written, 'For your sake we are being killed all the day long; we are regarded as sheep to be slaughtered.' ³⁷ No, in all these things we are more than conquerors <u>through him</u> who loved us."

Praying to Prevail

<u>Psalm 60:11-12</u> $-^{11}$ "Oh, grant us help against the foe, for vain is the salvation of man! ¹² <u>With God we shall do valiantly</u>; it is he who will tread down our foes."

<u>Psalm 25:2</u> – "O my God, in you I trust; <u>let me not be put to shame</u>; let not my enemies exult over me."

<u>Philippians 4:5-7</u> – ⁵ "... The Lord is at hand; ⁶ do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. ⁷ And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus."

<u>Luke 21:34-36</u> – ³⁴ "But watch yourselves lest your hearts be weighed down with dissipation and drunkenness and cares of this life, and that day come upon you suddenly like a trap. ³⁵ For it will come upon all who dwell on the face of the whole earth. ³⁶ But stay awake at all times, <u>praying that you may have strength to escape all these things that are going to take place</u>, and to stand before the Son of Man."

Staying to Prevail

<u>Luke 22:28-29</u> $-^{28}$ "You are those who have stayed with me in my trials, ²⁹ and I assign to you, as my Father assigned to me, a kingdom,"

<u>2 Timothy 1:12</u> – "That is why I am suffering here in prison. But I am not ashamed of it, for I know the one in whom I trust, and I am sure that he is able to guard what I have entrusted to him until the day of his return." (NLT)

Positive Pressure?

<u>Acts 5:40-41</u> - ⁴⁰ "And when they had called in the apostles, they beat them and charged them not to speak in the name of Jesus, and let them go. ⁴¹ Then they left the presence of the council, rejoicing that they were counted worthy to suffer dishonor for the name."

<u>Psalm 119:67, 71, 75</u> – ⁶⁷ "Before I was afflicted I went astray, but now I keep your word. ⁷¹ It is good for me that I was afflicted, that I might learn your statutes. ⁷⁵ I know, O LORD, that your rules are righteous, and that in faithfulness you have afflicted me."
