"And again, 'I will put my trust in him.' And again, 'Behold, I and the children God has given me."" (Hebrews 2:13)

Trusting The Father from Start to Finish

<u>Matthew 1:18</u> – "Now the birth of Jesus Christ took place in this way. When his mother Mary had been betrothed to Joseph, before they came together she was found to be with child from the Holy Spirit."

<u>Matthew 2:13-15</u> – (13) "Now when they had departed, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to Joseph in a dream and said, 'Rise, take the child and his mother, and flee to Egypt, and remain there until I tell you, for Herod is about to search for the child, to destroy him.' (14) And he rose and took the child and his mother by night and departed to Egypt (15) and remained there until the death of Herod. This was to fulfill what the Lord had spoken by the prophet, 'Out of Egypt I called my son.'"

<u>Luke 10:21-22</u> – (21) "In that same hour he rejoiced in the Holy Spirit and said, 'I thank you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that you have hidden these things from the wise and understanding and revealed them to little children; yes, Father, for such was your gracious will. (22) All things have been handed over to me by my Father, and no one knows who the Son is except the Father, or who the Father is except the Son and anyone to whom the Son chooses to reveal him.'"

<u>John 13:2-3</u> – (2) During supper, when the devil had already put it into the heart of Judas Iscariot, Simon's son, to betray him, (3) Jesus, knowing that the Father had given all things into his hands, and that he had come from God and was going back to God..."

<u>John 19:10-11</u> – (10) "So Pilate said to him, 'You will not speak to me? Do you not know that I have authority to release you and authority to crucify you?' (11) Jesus answered him, 'You would have no authority over me at all unless it had been given you from above. Therefore he who delivered me over to you has the greater sin.'"

<u>Luke 23:46</u> – "Then Jesus, calling out with a loud voice, said, 'Father, into your hands I commit my spirit!' And having said this he breathed his last."

<u>Acts 2:24-28</u> – (24) "God raised him up, loosing the pangs of death, because it was not possible for him to be held by it. (25) For David says concerning him, 'I saw the Lord

always before me, for he is at my right hand that I may not be shaken; (26) therefore my heart was glad, and my tongue rejoiced; my flesh also will dwell in hope. (27) For you will not abandon my soul to Hades, or let your Holy One see corruption. (28) You have made known to me the paths of life; you will make me full of gladness with your presence."

How His Enemies Described Him

<u>Matthew 27:41-43</u> – (41) "So also the chief priests, with the scribes and elders, mocked him, saying, (42) 'He saved others; he cannot save himself. He is the King of Israel; let him come down now from the cross, and we will believe in him. (43) <u>He trusts in God</u>; let God deliver him now, if he desires him. For he said, 'I am the Son of God.'"

En*trust*ment

<u>John 14:25-27</u> – (25) "These things I have spoken to you while I am still with you. (26) But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, he will teach you all things and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you. (27) <u>Peace I leave</u> <u>with you; my peace I give to you</u>. Not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid."

<u>Hebrews 4:9-11</u> – (9) So then, there remains a Sabbath rest for the people of God, (10) for whoever has entered God's rest has also rested from his works as God did from his. (11) <u>Let us therefore strive to enter that rest</u>, so that no one may fall by the same sort of disobedience."

<u>Hebrews 6:1</u> – "Therefore let us leave the elementary doctrine of Christ and go on to maturity, not laying again a foundation of repentance from dead works <u>and of faith toward</u> <u>God</u>,"

<u>Philippians 4:6-7</u> – (6) "Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. (7) And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus."
