Creation Clues

<u>Genesis 1:1-3</u> - (1) "In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth. (2) The earth was without form and void, and darkness was over the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters. (3) And God said, 'Let there be light,' and there was light."

<u>2 Corinthians 4:6</u> – "For God, who said, "Let light shine out of darkness," has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ."

Divine Disclosure

<u>John 1:1,14</u> – (1) "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. (14) And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth."

<u>John 1:4-5, 9</u> – (4) "In him was life, and the life was the light of men. (5) The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it. (9) The true light, which gives light to everyone, was coming into the world."

<u>John 3:19</u> – "And this is the judgment: the light has come into the world, and people loved the darkness rather than the light because their works were evil."

<u>John 1:11-13</u> – (11) "He came to his own, and his own people did not receive him. (12) But to all who did receive him, who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God, (13) who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God."

<u>John 3:3</u> – "Jesus answered him, 'Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born again he cannot see the kingdom of God."

Jesus - Our Guide through Life

<u>John 16:12-13</u> – (12) "I still have many things to say to you, but you cannot bear them now. (13) When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all the truth, for he will not speak on his own authority, but whatever he hears he will speak, and he will declare to you the things that are to come."

Revelation Correlation - Desire & Diligence

<u>Deuteronomy 29:29</u> – "The secret things belong to the LORD our God, but the things that are revealed belong to us and to our children forever, that we may do all the words of this law."

<u>Proverbs 25:2</u> – "It is the glory of God to conceal things, but the glory of kings is to search things out."

<u>Hebrews 11:6</u> – "And without faith it is impossible to please him, for whoever would draw near tood must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who seek (*ekzeteo – investigate, crave, demand*) him."

Mark 4:10-11 – (10) "And when he was alone, those around him with the twelve asked him about the parables. (11) And he said to them, "To you has been given the secret of the kingdom of God, but for those outside everything is in parables"
