Hezekiah's Pride

2 Kings 20:12-19 – (12) "At that time Merodach-baladan the son of Baladan, king of Babylon, sent envoys with letters and a present to Hezekiah, for he heard that Hezekiah had been sick. (13) And Hezekiah welcomed them, and he showed them all his treasure house, the silver, the gold, the spices, the precious oil, his armory, all that was found in his storehouses. There was nothing in his house or in all his realm that Hezekiah did not show them. (14) Then Isaiah the prophet came to King Hezekiah, and said to him, 'What did these men say? And from where did they come to you?' And Hezekiah said, 'They have come from a far country, from Babylon.' (15) He said, 'What have they seen in your house?' And Hezekiah answered, 'They have seen all that is in my house; there is nothing in my storehouses that I did not show them.' (16) Then Isaiah said to Hezekiah, 'Hear the word of the LORD: (17) Behold, the days are coming, when all that is in your house, and that which your fathers have stored up till this day, shall be carried to Babylon. Nothing shall be left, says the LORD. (18) And some of your own sons, who shall be born to you, shall be taken away, and they shall be eunuchs in the palace of the king of Babylon.' (19) Then Hezekiah said to Isaiah, 'The word of the LORD that you have spoken is good.' For he thought, 'Why not, if there will be peace and security in my days?'"

<u>James 4:13-16</u> – (13) "Come now, you who say, 'Today or tomorrow we will go into such and such a town and spend a year there and trade and make a profit'— (14) yet you do not know what tomorrow will bring. What is your life? For you are a mist that appears for a little time and then vanishes. (15) Instead you ought to say, 'If the Lord wills, we will live and do this or that.' (16) As it is, you boast in your arrogance. All such boasting is evil."

<u>1 Corinthians 10:12</u> – "Therefore let anyone who thinks that he stands take heed lest he fall."
