Nervous Compliance

<u>Daniel 3:6-7</u> – (6) "And whoever does not fall down and worship shall immediately be cast into a burning fiery furnace. (7) Therefore, as soon as all the peoples heard the sound of the horn, pipe, lyre, trigon, harp, bagpipe, and every kind of music, all the peoples, nations, and languages fell down and worshiped the golden image that King Nebuchadnezzar had set up."

Our Grotesque Statues:

(1) Social Status

<u>John 12:42-43</u> – (42) "Yet at the same time many even among the leaders believed in him. But because of the Pharisees they would not confess their faith for fear they would be put out of the synagogue; (43) for they loved praise from men more than praise from God." (NIV)

<u>Galatians 1:10</u> – "For am I now seeking the approval of man, or of God? Or am I trying to please man? If I were still trying to please man, I would not be a servant of Christ."

(2) Financial "Security"

<u>Proverbs 18:11</u> – "A rich man's wealth is his strong city, and like a high wall in his imagination."

1 Timothy 6:9-10 – (9) "But those who desire to be rich fall into temptation, into a snare, into many senseless and harmful desires that plunge people into ruin and destruction. (10) For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evils. It is through this craving that some have wandered away from the faith and pierced themselves with many pangs."

(3) Confidence in Flesh

<u>Psalm 146:3-4</u> – (3) "Don't put your confidence in powerful people; there is no help for you there. (4) When they breathe their last, they return to the earth, and all their plans die with them." (NLT)

(4) Longevity
