Aggrieving Jesus

<u>Mark 3:1-6</u> – (1) "Again he entered the synagogue, and a man was there with a withered hand. (2) And they watched Jesus, to see whether he would heal him on the Sabbath, so that they might accuse him. (3) And he said to the man with the withered hand, "Come here." (4) And he said to them, 'Is it lawful on the Sabbath to do good or to do harm, to save life or to kill?' But they were silent. (5) And he looked around at them with anger, grieved at their hardness of heart, and said to the man, 'Stretch out your hand.' He stretched it out, and his hand was restored. (6) The Pharisees went out and immediately held counsel with the Herodians against him, how to destroy him."

A Grieving Jesus

<u>John 11:33-37</u> – (33) "When Jesus saw her weeping, and the Jews who had come with her also weeping, he was deeply moved in his spirit and greatly troubled. (34) And he said, 'Where have you laid him?' They said to him, 'Lord, come and see.' (35) Jesus wept. (36) So the Jews said, 'See how he loved him!' (37) But some of them said, 'Could not he who opened the eyes of the blind man also have kept this man from dying?'"

Good Grief

<u>John 16:20</u> – "Truly, truly, I say to you, you will weep and lament, but the world will rejoice. You will be sorrowful, but your sorrow will turn into joy."

<u>1 Thessalonians 4:13</u> – "But we do not want you to be uninformed, brothers, about those who are asleep, that you may not grieve as others do who have no hope."

(28) Likewise, just as it was in the days of Lot—they were eating and drinking, buying and selling, planting and building, (29) but on the day when Lot went out from Sodom, fire and sulfur rained from heaven and destroyed them all— (30) so will it be on the day when the Son of Man is revealed."

Daniel 7:25 – "He shall speak words against the Most High, <u>and shall wear out the saints</u> <u>of the Most High</u>, and shall think to change the times and the law; and they shall be given into his hand for a time, times, and half a time."

<u>2 Peter 2:7-9</u> – (7) "And if he rescued righteous Lot, greatly distressed by the sensual conduct of the wicked (8) (for as that righteous man lived among them day after day, he was tormenting his righteous soul over their lawless deeds that he saw and heard); (9) then the Lord knows how to rescue the godly from trials, and to keep the unrighteous under punishment until the day of judgment,"
