...My Labor is in Vain

<u>Isaiah 49:1-4</u> – (1) "Listen to me, O coastlands, and give attention, you peoples from afar. The LORD called me from the womb, from the body of my mother he named my name. (2) He made my mouth like a sharp sword; in the shadow of his hand he hid me; he made me a polished arrow; in his quiver he hid me away. (3) And he said to me, 'You are my servant, Israel, in whom I will be glorified.' (4) But I said, 'I have labored in vain; I have spent my strength for nothing and vanity; yet surely my right is with the LORD, and my recompense with my God."

The Complaint of the Righteous

1 Samuel 25:21-22 – (21) "Now David had said, 'Surely in vain have I guarded all that this fellow has in the wilderness, so that nothing was missed of all that belonged to him, and he has returned me evil for good. (22) God do so to the enemies of David and more also, if by morning I leave so much as one male of all who belong to him."

<u>Psalm 73:13-14</u> – (13) "Did I keep my heart pure for nothing? Did I keep myself innocent for no reason? (14) I get nothing but trouble all day long; every morning brings me pain." (NLT)

Malachi 3:14 – "You have said, 'It is vain to serve God. What is the profit of our keeping his charge or of walking as in mourning before the LORD of hosts?"

Compensation Motivation

<u>Hebrews 12:2</u> – "...Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God."

Serving with Hope
