(27) Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid."

Acts 2:38 – "And Peter said to them, 'Repent and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit."

Acts 9:31 – "So the church throughout all Judea and Galilee and Samaria had peace and was being built up. And walking in the fear of the Lord <u>and in the comfort of the Holy Spirit, it multiplied."</u>

Romans 8:15 – (15) "For you did not receive the spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you have received the Spirit of adoption as sons, by whom we cry, 'Abba! Father!' (16) The Spirit himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God,"

1 Corinthians 3:16-17 – (16) "Do you not know that you are God's temple and that God's Spirit dwells in you? (17) If anyone destroys God's temple, God will destroy him. For God's temple is holy, and you are that temple."

Acts 16:6-7 – (6) "And they went through the region of Phrygia and Galatia, having been forbidden by the Holy Spirit to speak the word in Asia. (7) And when they had come up to Mysia, they attempted to go into Bithynia, but the Spirit of Jesus did not allow them."

<u>1 Timothy 4:1</u> – "Now the Spirit expressly says that in later times some will depart from the faith by devoting themselves to deceitful spirits and teachings of demons"

Revelation 2:7, 11, 17, 29, 3:6, 13, 22 – "He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches."
