Jesus - Had a Soft Heart

<u>Luke 7:13</u> – "And when the Lord saw her, he had compassion on her and said to her, 'Do not weep.'"

<u>Matthew 20:34</u> – "<u>Moved with compassion</u>, Jesus touched their eyes; and immediately they regained their sight and followed Him." (NASB)

<u>Matthew 9:36</u> – "But when he saw the multitudes, he was <u>moved with compassion</u> on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd." (KJV)

<u>Matthew 14:13-14</u> – (13) "When Jesus heard *of it*, he departed thence by ship into a desert place apart: and when the people had heard *thereof*, they followed him on foot out of the cities. (14) And Jesus went forth, and saw a great multitude, and was <u>moved with compassion</u> toward them, and he healed their sick." (KJV)

John 11:35 – "Jesus wept."

<u>Luke 19:41-44</u> – (41) "And when he drew near and saw the city, <u>he wept over it</u>, (42) saying, 'Would that you, even you, had known on this day the things that make for peace! But now they are hidden from your eyes. (43) For the days will come upon you, when your enemies will set up a barricade around you and surround you and hem you in on every side (44) and tear you down to the ground, you and your children within you. And they will not leave one stone upon another in you, because you did not know the time of your visitation."

Heart Transplant

Ezekiel 36:26 – "And I will give you a new heart, and a new spirit I will put within you. And I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh."

Romans 10:9-10 – (9) "...If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord <u>and believe</u> in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. (10) <u>For with the heart one believes and is justified</u>, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved."

Heart Monitor

Proverbs 4:23 – "Keep your heart with all vigilance, for from it flow the springs of life."

Ephesians 1:16, 18 – (16) "I do not cease to give thanks for you, remembering you in my prayers... (18) having the eyes of your hearts enlightened, that you may know what is the hope to which he has called you..."

Heart Hardening Hazards

<u>Hebrews 3:12-13</u> – (12) "Take care, brothers, <u>lest there be in any of you an evil, unbelieving heart, leading you to fall away from the living God.</u> (13) But exhort one another every day, as long as it is called 'today,' that none of you may be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin."

Zechariah 7:11-12 – (11) "But they refused to pay attention and turned a stubborn shoulder and stopped their ears that they might not hear. (12) They made their hearts diamond-hard lest they should hear the law and the words that the LORD of hosts had sent by his Spirit through the former prophets. Therefore great anger came from the LORD of hosts."

Ecclesiastes 7:21 – "Do not take to heart all the things that people say, lest you hear your servant cursing you."

Matthew 24:12 – "And because lawlessness will be increased, the love of many will grow cold."
