"Getting a Jump on Judgment"

"For it is time for judgment to begin at the household of God; and if it begins with us, what will be the outcome for those who do not obey the gospel of God?" (1 Peter 4:17)

Commencement of Judgment

<u>John 3:17-21</u> – ¹⁷ "For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him. ¹⁸ Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only Son of God. ¹⁹ And this is the judgment: the light has come into the world, and people loved the darkness rather than the light because their works were evil. ²⁰ For everyone who does wicked things hates the light and does not come to the light, lest his works should be exposed. ²¹ <u>But whoever does what is true</u> <u>comes to the light, so that it may be clearly seen that his works have been</u> <u>carried out in God</u>."

Proactive/Preventive Self Examination

<u>1 Corinthians 11:31-32</u> $-^{31}$ "But if we judged ourselves truly, we would not be judged. ³² But when we are judged by the Lord, we are disciplined so that we may not be condemned along with the world."

<u>2 Corinthians 13:5</u> – "Examine yourselves, to see whether you are in the faith. Test yourselves. Or do you not realize this about yourselves, that Jesus Christ is in you?—unless indeed you fail to meet the test!"

<u>Psalm 26:2</u> – "Put me on trial, LORD, and cross-examine me. Test my motives and my heart." (NLT)

<u>Psalm 139:23-24</u> – ²³ "Search me, O God, and know my heart! Try me and know my thoughts! ²⁴ And see if there be any grievous way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting!"

Words Count

<u>Matthew 12:36-37</u> $-^{36}$ "I tell you, on the day of judgment people will give account for every careless word they speak, ³⁷ for by your words you will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned."

<u>Ecclesiastes 5:1-2</u> $-^{1}$ "Guard your steps when you go to the house of God. To draw near to listen is better than to offer the sacrifice of fools, for they do not know that they are doing evil.² Be not rash with your mouth, nor let your heart be hasty to utter a word before God, for God is in heaven and you are on earth. Therefore let your words be few."

Relationships

<u>Romans 14:10-13</u> – ¹⁰ "Why do you pass judgment on your brother? Or you, why do you despise your brother? For we will all stand before the judgment seat of God; ¹¹ for it is written, 'As I live, says the Lord, every knee shall bow to me, and every tongue shall confess to God.' ¹² So then each of us will give an account of himself to God. ¹³ Therefore let us not pass judgment on one another any longer, but rather decide never to put a stumbling block or hindrance in the way of a brother."

Warning the World

<u>Proverbs 24:11-12</u> - ¹¹ "Rescue those who are being taken away to death; hold back those who are stumbling to the slaughter. ¹² If you say, 'Behold, we did not know this,' does not he who weighs the heart perceive it? Does not he who keeps watch over your soul know it, and will he not repay man according to his work?"
