Paths of Destruction

(1) "Path-Illogical" Pursuits

Psalm 49:5-13 – 5"Why should I fear in times of trouble, when the iniquity of those who cheat me surrounds me, 6 those who trust in their wealth and boast of the abundance of their riches? 7Truly no man can ransom another, or give to God the price of his life, 8 for the ransom of their life is costly and can never suffice, 9 that he should live on forever and never see the pit. 10 For he sees that even the wise die; the fool and the stupid alike must perish and leave their wealth to others. 11 Their graves are their homes forever, (Septuagint, Syriac, Targum; Hebrew- Their inward thought was that their homes were forever) their dwelling places to all generations, though they called lands by their own names. 12 Man in his pomp will not remain; he is like the beasts that perish. 13 This is the path of those who have foolish confidence; yet after them people approve of their boasts."

<u>Psalm 52:6-7</u> – ⁶"The righteous shall see and fear, and shall laugh at him, saying, ⁷'See the man who would not make God his refuge, <u>but trusted in the abundance of his riches and sought refuge in his own destruction!""</u>

(2) "Wanderlusts"

<u>Proverbs 7:21-27</u> – ²¹"With much seductive speech she persuades him; with her smooth talk she compels him. ²²<u>All at once he follows her</u>, as an ox goes to the slaughter, or as a stag is caught fast ²³till an arrow pierces its liver; as a bird rushes into a snare; he does not know that it will cost him his life. ²⁴And now, O sons, listen to me, and be attentive to the words of my mouth. ²⁵<u>Let not</u> your heart turn aside to her ways; do not stray into her paths, ²⁶for many a

victim has she laid low, and all her slain are a mighty throng. ²⁷Her house is the way to Sheol, going down to the chambers of death."

<u>Proverbs 4:14-15</u> – ¹⁴"Do not enter the path of the wicked, and do not walk in the way of the evil. ¹⁵Avoid it; do not go on it; turn away from it and pass on."

Path of Life

<u>Proverbs 15:24</u> – "<u>The path of life leads upward for the prudent</u>, that he may turn away from Sheol beneath."

<u>Psalm 16:11</u> – "You make known to me the path of life; in your presence there is fullness of joy; at your right hand are pleasures forevermore."

<u>Matthew 4:18-19</u> – ¹⁸"While walking by the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers, Simon (who is called Peter) and Andrew his brother, casting a net into the sea, for they were fishermen. ¹⁹And he said to them, '<u>Follow me</u>, and I will make you fishers of men.'"
